Venue: Tamworth High School

Time: 1:30pm- 3:20pm (after the first four classes)

Roll call: 9:00am and 1:30pm at Tamworth High School

Cost: Nil (covered by school)

Required Attire: Bring a spare white shirt or a shirt in house colours (colour does wash out)

Items provided: Water station provided and a Zooper Dooper provided at the end of the course

The Tamworth High School Cross Country Carnival, this year will be a colour run and is being held on Thursday 31 May from 1:30pm – 3.20 pm at Tamworth High School, **there will be coloured powder flying around so please remember to bring a white shirt.** Students are to arrive at Tamworth High School for a 9am start as per usual in correct uniform. Students will need to bring their change of clothes for the day with them. School will run for the first four classes on a normal timetable. There will be a roll call at 1:30pm where the students will have their name marked off before the colour run begins.

The success of the Colour Run depends not only on attendance, but also on the level of student **PARTICIPATION**. To allow everyone to participate fully we have chosen to change the traditional Cross Country carnival to a Colour Run. The coloured powder is asthmatic and allergen friendly, but if there are any concerns please make sure the student has a note and they will be given a sash and directed to walk around the colour stations

Students will be required to wear their Sports Uniform to the school however they may get changed at lunch into their chosen shirt (preferably in a white shirt) provided it is in their **house colours or white**. The cost of this event per student will be covered by the school this year. The event is run after lunch so no food will be provided however appropriate water stations will be provided and the students will be given a Zooper Dooper at the end of the course. Parents/carers will be able to pick up students at approximately 3.20pm, provisions will also be made to make sure students can catch their regular bus, however they will need to change back into their uniform before catching this transport.

All staff and elected student House Representatives are primed for a big, exciting and enjoyable Colour Run and all that is required now is the participation of all Tamworth High School students in order to ensure the Colour Run's success.
